Rubrik has introduced “Agent Rewind,” a new feature aimed at mitigating the potential damage caused by malfunctioning or compromised AI agents.

The tool allows organisations to swiftly revert malicious or faulty agent actions and restore critical system states, bringing a new level of resilience to enterprise environments increasingly dependent on generative AI.

## ESET Discovers PromptLock: The First AI-Powered Ransomware

PromptLock, the first known ransomware strain powered by generative AI has been uncovered by ESET.

Capable of producing deceptive phishing emails and adapting to language contexts, this malware represents a significant shift in threat sophistication.

By leveraging ChatGPT-generated prompts, PromptLock highlights how AI can be manipulated for malicious purposes, signalling an urgent need for new defensive strategies. Its emergence underscores the growing risks posed by AI weaponisation in cybercrime.

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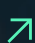
